

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Inglewood Heritage Centre

The Inglewood Heritage Centre has gone back to the very beginnings of European settlement of the district with the latest exhibition: A History of the Sawmills and Timber yards in the Inglewood Area.

Did you know a Mr Beaton started up the first sawmill in the Inglewood area and from 1876 to 1994 there were at least twenty one different sawmills? Sawmilling played a huge part in clearing areas of bushland for farming and the building of homes and businesses.

In the early days apart from labour on roads and railway construction, practically the only other industry was sawmilling. When the first settlers arrived, Inglewood was dense rain forest. A contract from the government for 20,000 railway sleepers for the railway gave employment to many locals. The first timber to go out of Inglewood by rail was 5000 feet of timber from Colonel Trimble's mill used in construction of the new Government buildings in New Plymouth.

Brown's sawmill was relocated to Inglewood on the junction of Hursthouse Road and Mountain Road, it was near the railway line and had a rail siding. The mill had its own blacksmith's shop and built its own wagons, drays and junkers. There was also a farm attached where the draft horses were housed.

The Bullock teams were eventually replaced by a Pulling Billy named 'Victoria' often also known as 'Brown's Coffee Pot'. 'Victoria' wound its way through many miles of bush in search of timber. In its heyday Brown's Mill employed 100 men, one fifth of the town's population. Come on down, check out your district's history, you may even see your relations in the old photos!

Phil Aish a dairy farmer who is a former student of Inglewood Primary (starting in 1944), founded the Tractor Trek after the passing of his beloved wife Janice to raise funds to give to hospice to thank them for their wonderful care. A farmer at heart, Phil was troubled about the dreadful suicide stats for farmers struggling with mental health due to stress and isolation. So in 2020 the Tractor Trek joined forces with Gumboot Friday. The trek visiting schools helps students develop the knowledge, understandings, skills, and attitudes to enhance their mental health, and increase their connections with friends and families. For students to discover skills to maintain their personal wellbeing and of their communities.
