

Since no two accidents are the same, no two extractions are the same.

Exercises like the one carried out recently at the Taranaki Civil yards, put the Fire and Emergency crews into a mode of having to adapt to situations as they present themselves. With any real incident the key focus is on the safety of the crew and helping anyone trapped to be freed as soon as possible along with the safety of the general public. They have to train to the best of their ability in as close to real life scenarios as possible. Crews are given very little information en-route which is often the case on real jobs, meaning a high level of communication is required. This scenario saw the brigade having to work in several areas.

The three willing patients, Josh, Jasmine and Simon played their roles well. Thank you and special thanks to Taranaki Civil for allowing the use of their site for training.




