I hate mornings. Especially early and cold ones. But 25th April was one of those mornings when we remembered that a tiny inconvenience to us was in honour of so many others who had battled freezing temperatures and stinking heat, terror, loneliness, rats, lice and every kind of physical and mental injury so we could live our lives in freedom and moan about those cold, early mornings.

Blurry eyed we made our warm drinks, drove towards the Inglewood memorial and walked to where the parade would finish. The cool air whipped around slightly in the dark and the neon strip lights gave off an uncomfortable, garish glow.

"Parade HALT!" came the order and a tear filled my eye as I saw a very elderly veteran, his chest adorned with medals, stumble as he tried to stay to attention; still a proud serviceman in spirit long after his military body had failed him.

All those in uniform stood there alongside each other as they had decades ago, together with some of those still serving aboard New Plymouth's HMNZS Aotearoa, and honoured their colleagues who had not returned. We, outsiders, most of whom could not imagine their lives, stood there in remembrance with them.

A few words, a poem, The Last Post and we all returned our separate ways.

At home over a fried breakfast we read war poetry by Wilfred Owen and Siegfried Sassoon; pores oozed over yellowed, fragile newspapers that after the war and read accounts of bravery, propaganda and death. We told our kids the stories our grandparents had told us and then we said a prayer, grateful that we hadn't ever had to experience what all those in the parade had had to experience. Grateful that others had done it instead. Last we forget. Thank you all for your service.
