

## New Flat Fare System for Taranaki Buses and Free Fares for WITT Students

Riding a public bus in Taranaki is a whole lot simpler, with the introduction of a new fare system. The number of bus fare zones in Taranaki reduced from 25 to just four. There will be a flat fare for all passengers within each zone, with an additional \$1 for each boundary crossed. For example, if you are travelling within Zone One will cost Bee Card users \$2. Zone one covers New Plymouth city and extends out to Waitara, Ōkara and Egmont Village. The charges reflect Citylink school and urban services as well as the regional Connector and Southlink services.

The Bee Card is a bus payment card which allows you to 'tag on and tag off' the bus. It provides you with cheaper fares and is able to be used across nine regions around New Zealand, including Taranaki. The Bee Card was introduced in Taranaki in 2020 and is used by 90% of passengers. Cash fares are still accepted on the buses. To order a Bee Card go to [www.bee-card.co.nz](http://www.bee-card.co.nz) or pick one up in person. WITT Students enjoy free bus travel with current student ID or course confirmation letter, as of 31 January 2022, students no longer need a Bee Card to enjoy free bus travel. WITT students must present their current WITT student ID upon boarding, or they may be charged the flat fare. For those who have not yet received their WITT student ID, please present a copy of your course confirmation letter to the driver upon boarding.
