Wildlife Centre on the Cards for Inglewood

EAST TARANAKI A proposal from the East Taranaki Environment Trust has set the ball rolling to ENVIRONMENT COLLECTIVE possibly have a multimillion dollar wildlife centre and kiwi viewing house for inglewood. The centre proposed would have a viewing house for at least two North Island western brown kiwi, a recovery centre for injured native animals, and education room, café and eventually a kiwi hatchery. The proposal has been moving through the motions, now with the Inglewood Community Board giving its support


The proposal has been moving through the motions, now with the righewood community bourd giving its support to NPCC to buy hand behind the joe GMS Reterev alongisher the Kungete Stream. The fast Transki Environment Trust based at Pungi presently cares for 13,000 protected hearters using trap and gast control. Within the lind there is western frown linku, kokaka, and long-tailed bass all are which protected. The trust would like to expand as the kink tread and spead out. The council are currently working with the trust and others. Howing forward if the council agrees the land would

need to be purchased and then leased for used for the wildlife centre. Then the centre would need to be panneed, with ideas including a bird hospital, education rooms, Brookland: Zoo could possibly move their animal hospital to the site, eventually they are hoping for a hatchery as currendly all livel eggs removed from nests in Tarnaki ago to Palmerston North or Rotorua to hatch, grow and then be re-released. With kiw activity increasing in Tarnaki a hatchery here is resonable. There is also talk of a wetland being restored alongside the centre.

The centre would not be funded by the council they would just lease the land. The trust believe that they would be able to raise the funds which are estimated to be around \$10 million to build and \$1 million a year to run. The centre would be a huge benefit to the Inglewood community attracting visitors along with employing staff and volunteer







New Flat Fare System for Taranaki Buses and Free Fares for Witt Students **Fare Zones**

Riding a public bus in Taranski is a whole lot simpler, with the introduction of a new fare system. The number of bus fare zones in Taranski reduced from 25 to just four. There will be a fat fare for all passengers within each zone, with an additional \$1 for each boundary crossed. For example, a trip anywhere within Zone One will cost Bee Card users \$2. Zone One covers New Plymouth city will cost bee Card users \$2. Zone One covers New Mymouth city and extends out to Waitara. Oslaura and Egmonr Village. The changes affect Clylink school and urban services as well as the regional Connector and Southink services. The Bee Card is a bus payment card which allows you to tag on and tag off the bus. It provides you with cheaper fares and is able to be used across nine regions around New Zealand, including

Taranaki. The Bee Card was introduced in Taranaki in 2020 and is used by 90% of passengers. Cash fares are still accepted on the buses. To order a Bee Card go to <u>www.beecard.conz</u> or pick one up in person. For a list of retailers go to <u>www.trc.govt.nz/bee-</u>
