New Groups for Vertical Horizon

With the help of a grant from the Pelorus Trust in early December, Vertical Horizon has been able to purchase three Ablespace ramps for the entries to Waititi Hall and the toilet block in Tariki Hall. Made of solid rubber and sprayed to prevent a trip hazard, these ramps are gold standard for accessibility. They make entry to these facilities easier for everyone and for moving machinery and equipment in and out of the buildings with trolleys. "The ramps finish off our Tariki Hall development and continue our improvements to make camp more accessible for everyone," says Camp Director Paul Hitchcock. "We are grateful to Pelorus Trust for making these improvements possible."

Garden Clues with Sue (Sue Harris)

Happy New Year to you all, and as weather wise it has been a great start to 2022, perfect holiday weather. The gardens and lawns are overdue for a bit of rain, as water restrictions are now in place, we need to have the odd wet day, yes to a day of rain, but many fine days in between! If you planted your vegetable patch, you should be now harvesting from the garden to your dinner table, and of course it's still summer, so keep planting, especially if you can keep them moist, as the plants settle in.

Birds also are keen harvesters, and you have to be quick to beat them to your much awaited crops, as they start to show any colour or starting bearing fruit. Personally, I have been watching and waiting to pick the first tomatoes, and was very prepared to pick slightly earlier, and let them ripen, only to find them disappeared within an hour of my checking their progress. Sorry neighbours if you heard any explosions when the said half eaten, half ripe tomato was found close by. Now I know the birds just want to enjoy a feed, and are paying me back, as I have secured my strawberries so well this year, that all they can do is look and not taste, but life is tough!
