Inglewood Rotary Club has the Christmas Sleigh Bells



SH3 Inglewood to Midhurst Roadwork's Complete

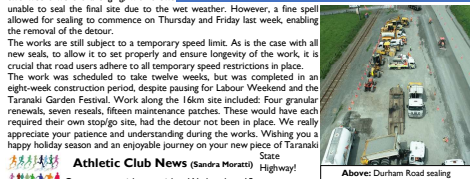
WAKA KOTAHĪ Nearly 4,000 cones and road signs have been removed from State Highway 3 between Inglewood and Midhurst, with work to rebuild several sections of the road now complete, and the detour removed.

Only one small site remains as crews work to complete the finishing touches at the Norfolk Road intersection. The past two weeks were challenging, with crews unable to seal the final site due to the wet weather. However, a fine spell allowed for sealing to commence on Thursday and Friday last week, enabling the removal of the detour.

The works are still subject to a temporary speed limit. As is the case with all new seals, to allow it to set properly and ensure longevity of the work, it is crucial that road users adhere to all temporary speed restrictions in place. The work was scheduled to take twelve weeks, but was completed in an eight-week construction period, despite pausing for Labour Weekend and the Taranaki Garden Festival. Work along the 16km site included: Four granular renewals, seven resals, fifteen maintenance patches. These would have each required their own stop/go site, had the detour not been in place. We really appreciate your patience and understanding during the works. Wishing you a happy holiday season and an enjoyable journey on your new piece of Taranaki State Highway!
