Gardening Clues With Sue (Sue Marsh)

A long weekend just around the corner. Labour Day, and with its arrival, officially it means to be the start of the warm weather. Garden Centres all around the country are ready for all you budding gardeners to descend on them this week, to start our summer plantings in earnest. We normally think potatoes, tomatoes and cucumbers, but what else can we plant. Kūmara also known as sweet potato, is a real Kiwi favourite. High in fibre and providing essential nutrients including calcium and iron, it is a superfood of the garden. Kūmara is a root crop that grows underground in a similar way to potatoes. A frost-tender crop that prefers a warmer climate and needs a hot summer, ideally kūmara enjoys a soil which is well cultivated to a depth of approximately 30cm, then has a hard pan underneath to stop the tubers from burying themselves too deeply.

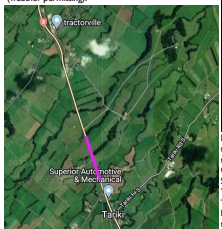
