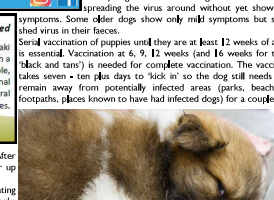

**Parvo Alert - Important** (Greg Hall)  
The serious gastrointestinal viral infection Parvo Virus has made a resurgence in dogs in Taranaki. We are seeing cases in both Waitara and Inglewood. This is a highly infectious and often fatal disease of dogs that causes severe gastrointestinal symptoms such as profuse vomiting, severe liquid foul smelling diarrhoea (often with blood), depression, lethargy, thirst, no appetite, rapid weight loss, shock and death. Treatment involves isolation, intravenous fluids, antibiotics, antiemetic medications and intensive care. Despite this the disease is often fatal in unvaccinated dogs and young dogs. The disease is spread by virus in infected faeces. The virus is really resistant and stays in the environment for seven plus months. Apparently healthy dogs that are incubating the disease can be spreading the virus around without yet showing symptoms. Some other dogs show only mild symptoms but still shed virus in their faeces. Serial vaccination of puppies until they are at least 12 weeks of age is essential. Vaccination at 6, 9, 12 weeks (and 16 weeks for the black and tan!) is needed for complete vaccination. The vaccine takes seven - ten plus days to 'kick in' so the dog still needs to remain away from potentially infected areas (parks, beaches, footpaths, places known to have infected dogs) for a couple of weeks following the 12 week vaccination. After proper vaccination the dog is protected for up to three years (variation occurs). We use strict isolation protocols for treating infected dogs. We believe vaccination works and is far cheaper than the cost of intensive care to treat the virus or the grief caused by the loss of your beloved dog. Take Parvo seriously and respect public areas where other dog owners frequent. Talk to us about getting your dogs Parvo vaccine up to date.



**Gardening with Clueless**  
Herbs! Let's talk about a herb that can be grown in January. Fresh basil is one of the summer garden's best crops. With its sweet aromatic flavour added to pasta and Asian cuisine it's sure to make your dish flavoursome. So choose a sunny spot close to your kitchen for easy access. Basil is best planted in late spring, summer and autumn as it needs warmth. Prepare your soil well by digging in organic matter like compost and sheep pellets. Add a layer of herb mix to plant into. Feed basil regularly to promote green leafy growth. Water your basil consistently but don't over water as it doesn't like getting its feet wet, or the cold and damp weather. Pick regularly to help avoid it going to seed. Basil is a herb that grows quite fast. It comes in all sizes, shapes, textures and flavours. A sunny windowsill is an ideal spot to grow if you live in cooler areas or if you have a greenhouse even better if you are wanting to grow all year round. So have a go and add basil to your garden today.
