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Restore PG Nops Reserve September

"Right plant Right place" was the topic of discussion at our September working bee after someone donated native plants for the Reserve. Three of them were Kauri trees. The natural southern limit of Kauri in Aotearoa is around Kawhia. Any Kauri present in Taranaki were planted by people. Reserves like PG Nops are precious because they are the only remaining native forest remnants in our community. We need to plant native plants which are either present in the reserve or would have been there historically. This preserves genetic integrity and supports overall ecosystem health and resilience. Plants found within Egmont Ecological District, which encompasses Inglewood, are adapted to our climate, soil, and environmental conditions so have a better chance of survival. The kauri trees will have to find a home elsewhere. In addition to planting we spent two hours weeding and laying bark over the cleared areas along Kurapete stream. Our next working bee is 1.00-3.00pm Sunday the 26th October. We meet at the Tawa Street entrance. We would love to see you there.
