So while they do their thing, we need you to think about growing your sunflowers for the Harvess Festival. Sunflowers are easy to grow from seed and it's time to plant	A gale
them now. Choose a sump patch of soil and give it a good water the day before you plant. If you are growing tail sumflowers, place stakes in the ground about 40cm apart, this will stop them blowing over in the wind. Beside each stake sow seeds about 1cm deep or the depth recommended on	
the packet. If you have plenty of seeds, sow in pairs and pull out the weakest when they start to grow. Water enough to	

out the weakest when they start to grow. Water enough to keep the sol moxing (not week), and then thes and water your plants as they grow and tie them gendy to their stakes with stretchy ties. When they start to grow, feed them with liquid fertiliser. Sufflowers attract good bugs such as lacewings, which each planks and cheap persess, which is great for your graden. So, while all this activity is happening, don't forget to organise your graden, ready for any visitors that you may have over the holding season. 
